
Title : Key design consideration of DCS

Speaker : Mr. Barry Lau Associate Director, Arup

Mr. Barry Lau is an Associate Director of ARUP, specialising in the design of large scale chilled water distribution system and district energy system. Barry is the deputy project manager of Kai Tak DCS system which is the first DCS implemented in Hong Kong. He also has extensive experience in design of thermal storage system and CHP design in China.

Programme Highlight :

District Cooling System (DCS) is a centralized cooling system which provides chilled water to the air-conditioning system of user buildings for cooling purpose. The central chiller plant supplies chilled water and conveys it to the user buildings via underground chilled water pipe network. DCS is particularly suitable for developments with high-density as mixed use development typical of modern cities allows a high utilization factor of the district system. The seminar will then give key design consideration of DCS with illustration of example.
