## Abstract:

Energizing Kowloon East is formulated under the CBD<sup>2</sup> strategy, which focuses on enhancing Connectivity, Branding, Design and Diversity. Energizing Kowloon East Office (EKEO) has been established to achieve the vision. A temporary office building for the EKEO team itself is also acting as a champion of sustainability by using a raft of integrated green building technologies and lean construction methods & low embodied energy materials to become Hong Kong's first low carbon temporary office. From this visit, the participants will have an opportunity to tour around the innovative and green aspects of EKEO Building. The innovative and green EKEO building is also the first temporary office building which has achieved the BEAM Plus Provisional Platinum rating conferred/ certified by the Hong Kong Green Building Council, demonstrating various environmental benefits.



**Energizing Kowloon East Office (EKEO)** 

EKEO Building showcases a new sustainable design concept with low carbon footprint. The building itself acts as a model for other future temporary buildings, including construction site offices in Hong Kong. More importantly, the Information Kiosk in the building displays EKE and Kai Tak Development (KTD) related exhibitions, and with the aid of educational resources, serves as an ideal venue for receiving the general public during public consultation and engagement activities. Moreover, the exhibitions also intend to demonstrate the achievements of EKE and KTD in terms of urban design, sustainable development, greenery provision, etc.
