Background:



The **International Commerce Centre** (ICC) is a 118-storey, 484 m (1,588 ft) commercial skyscraper completed in 2010 in West Kowloon, Hong Kong where was built on top of Kowloon Station. ICC is currently the world's seventh tallest building by height as well as the tallest building in Hong Kong. Jointly developed by Sun Hung Kai Properties and MTR Corporation, the ICC includes 2.5 million square feet of Grade A office space, an Observation Deck and the six-star Ritz Carlton Hotel at the high zone.

ICC comprises of the most modern technologies in terms of energy and cost efficiency. This technical visit will offer a chance for participants to appreciate and experience the design,

installation and operation of major building services systems of the building through presentation, plant room visit and sharing with experienced building operation & maintenance team. The team will also share their experiences on the building air-conditioning system life-cycle commissioning and optimization as well as other innovative sustainable approaches on building operation and maintenance to achieve energy efficient building.
