

Visit Highlights:

Over the years, landfilling has been the only means of sludge disposal. T · PARK receives sludge from 11 major Sewage Treatment Works throughout the territory with a treatment capacity of up to



2,000 tonnes of sludge per day. Adopting advanced incineration technology, T · PARK reduces 90% of the orginal volume of sludge into ash and residues.

The self-sustained facility combines a variety of advanced technologies with recreational, educational and ecological features in a single complex. No external supply of water and electricty is

requried to support the daily operation of the entire facility. The heat energy produced from the sludge incineration process is recovered and converted into electricity by Steam Turbine Generator.
