Energizing Kowloon East Office (EKEO) was established to facilitate transformation of Kowloon East into another premier CBD of Hong Kong to support the economic growth and strengthen our global competitiveness. The EKEO office is a two-storey building which can accommodate 20 staff and 50 visitors out of an area of 3,600 m<sup>2</sup> underneath the Kwun Tong Bypass. This office is an innovative and sustainable building by using different integrated green building technologies and features, lean construction methods and low embodied energy materials to become Hong Kong's first low carbon temporary office with BEAM Plus NB V1.1 Platinum rating.
