ISO 41001 is a new ISO standard in facility management system. The new standard aims to help facilities management teams improve efficiencies across a range of areas, from procurement to operations to maintenance. Facility management is the organizational function that integrates people, place and process within the built environment, with the purpose of improving the quality of life of people and the productivity of the core business.

ISO 41001 provides structure organizing facility operations through resource management, value of money, workplace standards, compliance, environmental impact and the overall efficiency and effectiveness of facilities and services satisfying the demand organization's needs. The standard provides a basis and a framework for organizations to improve operational activities and risks, achieve organizational performance objectives and contribute to our quality of life.
