







Joint Technical Seminar on "Building Airtightness on Energy Conservation"

Programme Highlight:

This seminar is a joint activity among HKIE-BSD, CIBSE HK Branch, ASHRAE-HKC and IVE (Morrison Hill).

The speaker coming over from UK will talk firstly on the history about how building airtightness in UK has become an issue and its impact on energy conservation. It then covers the causes of air leakage, and how buildings are tested with air leakage paths identified. To tackle the issue on how buildings are designed toward achieving airtightness through drawing review, applying different methods of sealing to different types of construction; and summing up with the outlook of the subject from the perspective of the UK building industry.

Speaker

Mr Tom Jones graduated in Applied Physics with over 40 years' experience in building services research and testing at the renowned UK Building Services Research & Information Associates (BSRIA Ltd). Tom has been involved in a wide variety of both research and client contracts associated with the built environment. These have mainly been concerned with the use of tracer gas, scavenging and delivery of anaesthetic gases, indoor microclimate, measurement of pollutant levels, and for the last 15 to 20 years air leakage within buildings which has included testing, design and fault finding. A great depth and breath of knowledge in assessing the build quality of retail, commercial and industrial buildings has been acquired. He is currently BSRIA's senior airtightness tester, site consultant and Technical Manager.
